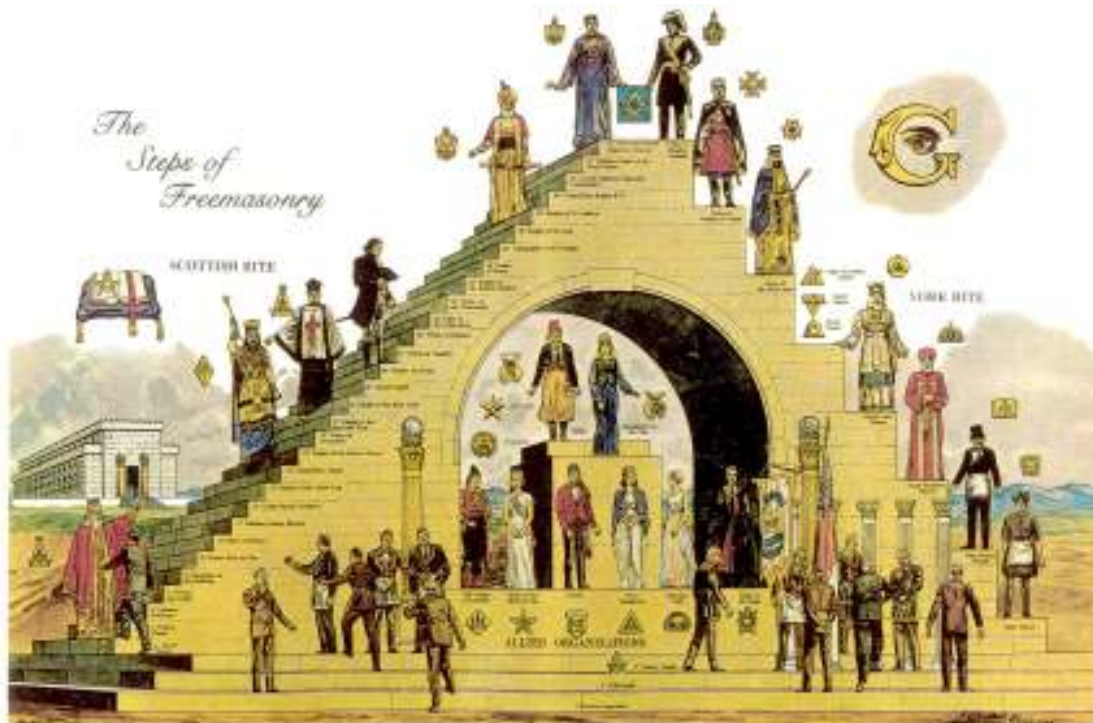
Brothers, we have a fall reunion so try to bring in new members. Our spring reunion was a huge success, so let’s make the fall reunion even better.

What are the 25 Landmarks of
Freemasonry? As the Months go by We
will cover them as we can. Here is the
first:

THE MODES OF RECOGNITION are,
of all the Landmarks, the most legitimate
and unquestioned. They admit of no
variation; and if ever they have suffered
alteration or addition, the evil of such a
violation of the ancient law has always
made itself subsequently manifest. An
admission of this is to be found in the
proceedings of the Masonic Congress at
Paris, where a proposition was presented

to render these
modes of
recognition once
more universal-
proposition which
never would have
been necessary, if
the integrity of
this important
Landmark had
been rigorously
preserved.
